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Download RMCProfile

On this page we provide links for downloading complete packages of the various versions of RMCProfile in a zip file. It is advisable to use the latest version unless you have a specific reason not to do so.

Each package contains the following:

- An executable version of the program RMCProfile v6
- A set of utility applications as executable versions
- A set of example files that form a tutorial as documented in the manual

We provide versions for three operating systems, click on the one you require (note that you will need an account name and password first, which you create for yourself by [http://lists.rmcpfile.org/mailman/listinfo/rmcpfile])

- Microsoft Windows
- Mac OS X
- Linux
- Manual

You are strongly recommended to use this version. users' experiences, particularly if there is something that doesn't work in the way you imagine it should.

Version 6.5 is actually a major update as it merges the previous version with and E... s version 6.4.8c can still be downloaded [here](#).

Installation instructions

To install RMCProfile on an Windows XP machine:

- Unzip the file once it has downloaded).
- Then copy the whole RMCProfile folder to a more permanent home, such as c:\RMCProfile. The folder should contain four folders (Examples, Manual, exe and tutorial) and a file called RMCProfile_setup.bat.
- To run the program double click on the RMCProfile_setup.bat file. This should bring up a command prompt window called RMCProfile.
- To get started open the mcprofile_tutorial.pdf file in the tutorial folder and follow the instructions. For more detailed information the RMCProfile manual can also be found in the manual folder or [here](#).

To install RMCProfile on an Windows Vista machine:

- The instructions above should work but unzip the file and folder permission could cause problems.
- If you use the free xserver Xming there is a known problem using atomeye that we are looking into
- We are aiming to up date these instruction soon, so please check back.

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
